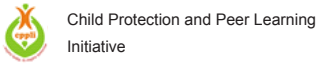
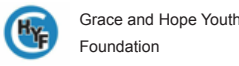

ABOUT THIS PLAN

Gude ward is part of Mubi-South LGA. It is one of the 7 Local Government Areas of Adamawa State that was affected by the Boko Haram insurgency in 2014. Apart from the destruction of physical infrastructures such as schools, water points, health centers etc. in the Local Government Area, people were killed and displaced and many others fled to safety. The physical and psychological trauma experienced during this time requires concerted efforts for the victims' full recovery.

Against this background, the Local Government and the traditional leaders of Mubi South LGA have put the reconstruction and long-term development based on the needs of the local population as their priority. With the support of the GIZ programme "Support to Strengthening Resilience in North-East Nigeria" (funded by the European Union and the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development), the Community Development Planning (CDP) process was implemented. The purpose was to bring together various community actors, vulnerable groups, women and men of different ages and socio-economic backgrounds together at ward level to plan for the development of their communities through a participatory bottom-up process.

The CDP process has provided the opportunity for community stakeholders to come together under one umbrella to discuss and analyze their livelihoods, problems, causes, strategies and potentials solutions. It is a process where members of a community are active participants in their problem identification, analysis of developmental issues affecting them and brainstorming on solutions to solve the problems. This is done while putting the peculiarity of their communities at the center of all the efforts.

While stakeholder sensitization, ward analysis and community mobilization played a crucial role in the CDP process, the Community Development Planning Session itself is the heart of the process. This 4-day session is akin to the village/town meetings where members of the community come together to discuss issues that affect their development and plan activities to overcome those development gaps. The major objectives of the CDP sessions are:

- To provide an opportunity for different socio-economic groups to discuss and analyse their livelihoods, including problems, causes, strategies and potentials within the community that could help them solve these problems
- To build people's capacity to participate more actively in development issues affecting them as individuals and their community as a whole
- To create a platform, where the people can discuss with their political and traditional leaders
- To identify and prioritize the needs of the community

Participants of the CDP session were carefully selected cutting across all demographics and socio-economic groups within the ward including vulnerable groups such as IDP, persons living with disability and orphaned children.

The CDP session was facilitated by the Governance Component of GIZ's Resilience Programme and their Civil Society Organisation (CSO) partners: Clear View Integrity Foundation (CVIF) and Grace & Hope Youth Foundation (GHYF), Child Protection and Peer Learning Initiative (CPPLI), Goggoji Zumunchi Development Initiative (GZDI), Zireenza Support

Foundation (ZSF) together with other members of the CDP team such as state/local government officials as well as traditional leaders who supported and guided the process.

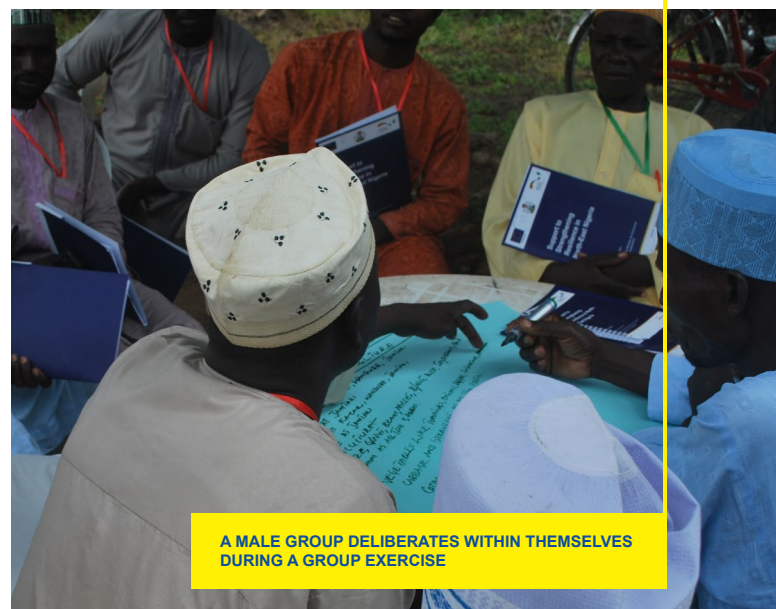
The tangible results of the Gude ward CDP process and especially the CDP session is this Ward Development Plan. The Plan and its content were validated by the representatives of the Gude Ward.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: KEY FINDINGS

The Community Development Planning (CDP) sessions took place in Gude ward from 19 – 22nd August 2019 at Gude Primary School. The CDP sessions were facilitated to provide a platform for all community stakeholders to identify, discuss community problems and proffer solutions; to train participants for active future engagements in matters of development and to create a joint vision and ward development plan. The participants identified the following as some of the resources found in our communities: Farmlands, economic trees, large population, food and cash crops, etc. Inadequate water supply, inadequate farm inputs, poor telecommunication network services, insecurity, etc. are some of the challenges hindering the development of our ward. At the end of sessions, a follow-up committee was established and tasked with the responsibility of advocating and lobbying for projects on behalf of our communities.

GUDE WARD AT A GLANCE

- The following are our villages: Kalari, Munduva A and B, Monduva Fulani, Ngavahi, Kida, Wuro – Patuji, Ngufawa, Gyadkwara A and B, Mawa, Kuvshara, Morgumba, Va’atita, Wandure and Jantari
- Gude ward has 2 District Heads, 2 Village Heads (Ardo) and 16 Ward Heads (Jauros)
- The major ethnic groups in Gude are Gude, Ffulde, Marghi, Hausa, Higgi, Kilba, Nzanyi, Matakam, Godogodo, Babur, Lakka, Daba, and Kanuri, etc.
- The major languages spoken are Gude, Ffulde, Marghi, Hausa, Higgi, Kilba, Nzanyi. Other less common languages are Matakam, Godogodo, Babur, Lakka, Daba, Kanuri and Igbo.
- The major religious practices of our people are Islam and Christianity

GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

Gude ward is in Mubi South Local Government Area of Adamawa State, Nigeria. It shares a geographic boundary with Gella, Yawa, Nasarawo, Lamorde, Mujara and Duvu wards within Mubi South Local Government Area. Gude ward is located in the outskirts of Mubi South with rocky terrains, streams and rivers. It has a very good and fertile ground for agriculture and livestock farming. Our ward is characterized by short dry season starting from January to April and a rainy season from May to October. Harmattan normally interrupts from mid-November to early February. Generally, the mean monthly temperature is always in the range of 21C to 35C. Gude to Mubi municipal is a 30 minutes’ drive with a car, 45 minutes’ drive with Keke-NAPEP and 1h 30 minutes on foot.

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

Gude ward is a relatively large population settlement with most of the population group ranging between 25 - 59 years. The major ethnic group in the community is Gude. There are also Hausa, Nzanyi, and Ffulde ethnic groups in the community. The major language spoken in the community is Gude followed by Hausa and Ffulde. Islam is the predominant religion followed by Christianity and an insignificantly small number of Traditional religious practitioners. Men are predominantly Heads of households with relatively few women as Heads of households. There are literarily no widowers in the community but a large number of widows. There is also an insignificant number of people living with disabilities in our community. Interestingly, the male population above age 25 is married to literarily. No male above 25 years still single or divorced.

ECONOMIC INFORMATION

The major crops that are cultivated in the ward are Maize, Beans, Rice, Millet, Groundnuts, Bambara nuts, and Tiger nuts. Others are Potatoes, Yam, Vegetables, Pepper, Sugarcane and Cassava. The

main market days in our communities are Wednesday and Thursdays. Typically, the types of jobs our men do are farming, animal rearing, business, trading, carpentry, masonry and commercial driving, among others. While our women engage in Selling of Akara, grinding, selling of firewood, cap knitting, Groundnut oil extraction and sales, tailoring, petty trading, and housekeeping.

The average earning per month of the male population of the community ranges between 5,000 - 10,000 Naira per month, while that of their female counterparts is an average of less than 5,000 Naira per month.

OUR VALUES

Respect for traditional, political and religious leaders, the elderly especially from the youths, hospitality, communal labour, honesty and hard work in addition to sharing gifts and love for our culture are some of our shared values we adhere to in the ward. Other values include Respect for husbands and in-laws, dressing decent and self-discipline.

OUR CHALLENGES

Despite the rich resources, our development faces challenges, which include all sectors and areas in our ward.

- Lack of electricity supply which negatively affects social and economic activities in our community
- Poor telecommunication network services in most parts of our community which affects the ease of communication in our community
- Poor roads and roads network in our community
- Lack of skills acquisition centre in our community for the training of our community youths in various skills and vocations.
- Lack of television viewing centres in our community
- There is a complete absence of modern sports facilities in our community
- The level of unemployment in our community is unusually high especially among the youths.
- There is inadequate and sometimes complete lack of modern farming inputs for farmers.
- There are no agricultural extension service workers in our community
- Most of the cattle routes are blocked as a result of an increase in farmlands and buildings within the community
- Inadequately qualified health workers in our health facilities.
- Drugs and hospital equipment are grossly inadequate
- An inadequate number of school teachers and where available, highly unqualified.
- Some communities within the ward don't have schools despite a large number of children within the age bracket e.g. in Vaatita, Kida, Jamtari, etc.
- Most of the schools in our community have dilapidated classroom blocks that require repairs
- Inadequate school furniture in our schools
- Acute water supply in our community and villages with no boreholes or completely broken-down boreholes
- Our community is still experiencing social issues like kidnapping, drug abuse among the youths, lack of Police stations, etc. despite the drastic decline in activities of the insurgents

THIS IS OUR DEVELOPMENT: PROBLEMS AND CAUSES, SOLUTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

To better understand our development needs, we collected, discussed and prioritised the problems in the ward that need our urgent attention. The tables below show the prioritization of problem sectors that came out of our internal voting process which was conducted first in different gender and age groups and then in the plenary of the CDP Session.

The problems identified were clustered in 7 major thematic sectors. These sectors are:

- i. Water and Sanitation
- ii. Economy
- iii. Agriculture and Food Security
- iv. Education
- v. Security
- vi. Health
- vii. Social Protection

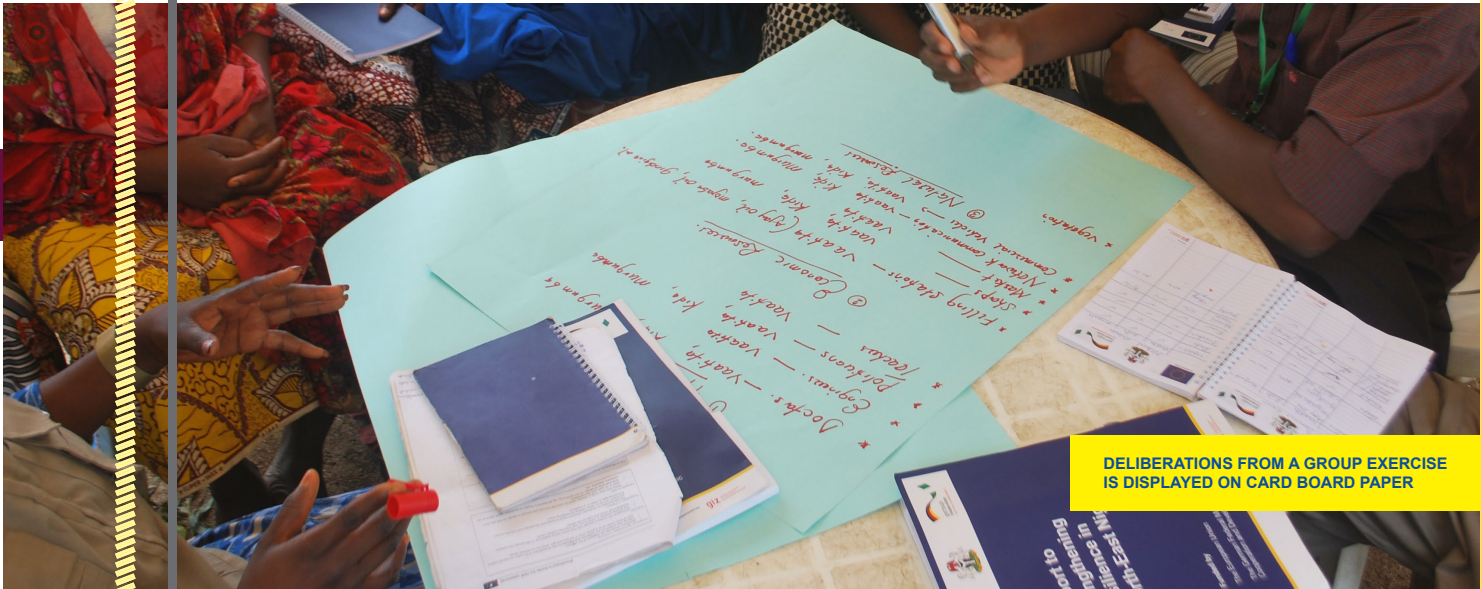
